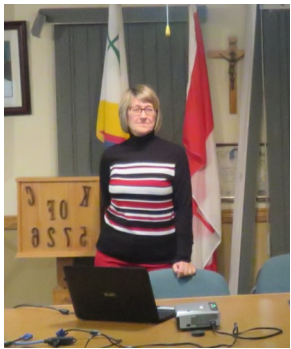

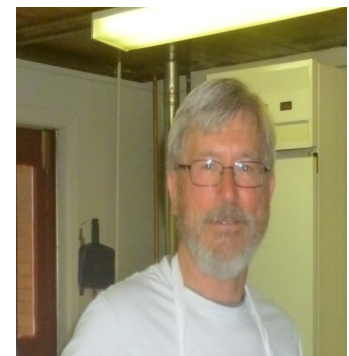

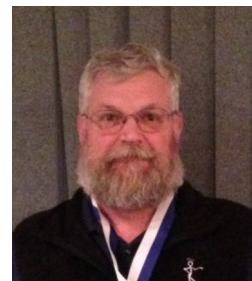
Honorary Life members, you should have received or will shortly receive your annual card to go with your plastic card, thank you for your long-term service.
