At most Masses we sing this song, we know it more as Glory to God in the highest. It is the song the angels sang to the shepherds, announcing the birth of our Saviour. It is and should always be a reminder to us that God so loved the world that He gave us

His only begotten Son.

Some major celebrations which will occur over the next two months.

- January 1st Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God (Octave Day of the Nativity of the Lord)
- January 2nd Memorial of St Basil the Great and St Gregory Nazianzen, Bishops and Doctors
- January 5th Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord
- January 12th Feast of the Baptism of the
- January 13th Start of Ordinary Time
- January 25th Feast of the Conversion of St Paul, Apostle
- February 2nd Feast of the Presentation of the Lord
- February 22nd Feast of the Chair of St Peter, Apostle
- March 5th Ash Wednesday Beginning of Lent

As I sit and reflect on the season, I can't help but see that in a little over two months we enter Lent. This may sound like it is fast approaching when in fact it is near the latest it can be which is March 10th. As such, the Church tries not to put too many celebrations in the month of February.

Even though we will turn our minds over to the Passion, we should not forget that the Christmas season for us lasts until January 12th, the Baptism of the Lord. Christmas is not just one day as our secular society would have you believe. Because they have been playing Christmas carols and holding Christmas sales since mid-November, they are ready to move on. Catholics on the other hand should have spent the time leading up to Christmas in a state of awe, as we reflect on His second coming and not His birth. It is not until November 17th when we turn to the scriptures about His birth.

Then Christmas and the Octave, the eight days we celebrate the Nativity of the Lord. A common question is how long Christmas is; the answer depends, it is eight days if talking about the Octave, it is twelve days if you go until Epiphany and what was the Feast of the Baptism. This is the origin of the song. With the Church separating Epiphany from the Baptism, it added up to a week to the Christmas season.

All this to say, you have the right and a bit of an obligation to say Merry Christmas all the way until January 12th.

May the Peace of Christ rest with you and your family and may you enjoy this Christmas Season and have a fruitful New Year. May this slightly longer than normal Ordinary Time before Lent serve as a time to learn more about our faith.
