Grand Knight's Report

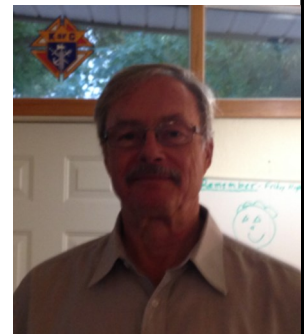
Brothers,

During last year's Supreme Convention of the Knights of Columbus, some changes were made to section 124 of the Constitution. Sec. 124 now says that "Each subordinate council shall hold at least two regular meetings each month, one of which is an officers' business meeting open to all members, and one shall be designated as a regular membership meeting." This section includes the order of business for the membership meeting, showing that the order of business does not include a Treasurer's report nor a Financial Secretary report. This means that while motions to disperse funds (ex: donations) can take place at the regular meeting, the "business" of paying bills and usual expenses will take place at the Officers' meeting. Minutes of both meetings will be recorded, of course, and presented at the membership regular meeting; which for our council is on the second Tuesday of the month. Our Council meetings will follow this pattern beginning September 1st, 2019.

When Father Kevin came to our Council meeting last Spring he asked us to be visible serving the parish, and for that purpose suggested that our Council serve all ministries at the first 9 AM mass of the month at Assumption Church. I want to express my sincere gratitude to Brother Dave Pittman for his tremendous work organizing brothers to serve the ministries for this mass since last September when we started doing this. I am sad to report that Brother Dave has regularly found it very difficult to find the 17 brothers needed to fill all ministries for these masses. He has expressed much frustration at this and has indicated that he will not coordinate this effort for next year. We have 122 brothers in our Council. Surely we can find 17 to serve mass one Sunday per month! Our Council requires one person to replace Dave. Please pray about this, and do respond to any calling you feel is yours to offer your time for coordinating this activity. I also encourage all Council 5726 brothers to open their hearts and commit to serving in a ministry at the first 9 AM mass of the month for the next Columbian year. (July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020)

At this time I want to give you advanced notice that the location of our Christmas party will change this year. The Parkbridge Estates Hall has been booked for council's annual Christmas party on December 13th. So, if you plan to attend our Christmas party this coming December please mark your calendars – not for Assumption Hall but for Parkbridge Estates Hall. The usual dine and dance will occur as usual.

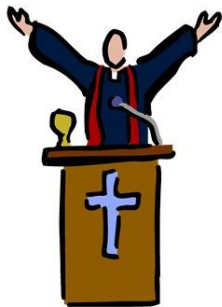

Friday May 31st K of C Clubhouse

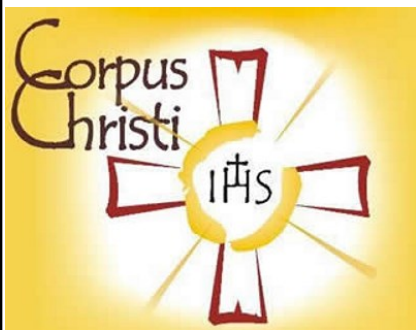

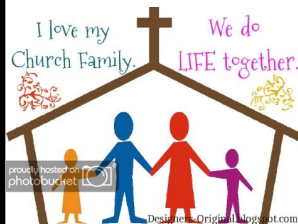

State Hockey Tournament, April 12th to 14th

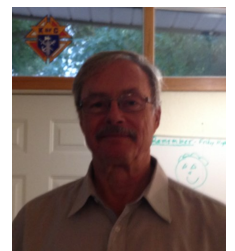

This last month has been a time of reflection and contemplation. I have been very busy helping prepare and welcome our Parish's younger members to the joy of receiving Jesus through the Eucharist. The joy I witnessed helped deepen my faith. This is why I find it very disheartening that we have been forced into the situation of cancelling our assistance at First Sunday Mass.

From a Council with 109 active members we can't seem to find 17 who will follow Jesus' call to serve and help our Priests to 'Feed his Sheep.' I am almost ashamed in the number and type of excuses. We all made vows during our Degree Ceremonies to grow in our faith and yet some of you have decided that status quo is the correct choice.

So, since when is it ok to express support and then just not show up? Or, why can't you, just once a month, participate in more than one Mass and help us be 'visible to the parish.' Or, since when can you say, 'I am too busy to help with Mass,' when as practical Catholics that is our obligation? Or, why is it ok to say, 'when I attend Mass I want to worship with my family and not do work? Do these questions hit close to home? They were meant to. Father has asked for only one thing from our council, for us as Knights to be 'Holy men, visible in our parish.' Our word should be our bond and when promised to work we should be there.
