Invitation to Participate

Our Council and through an invitation to the other three Councils of our city have begun a process with the Galt Museum and Archives to preserve the rich historical records and artifacts of the Knights of Columbus in the City of Lethbridge.

There are a few records presently found in the Museum Archives. These artifacts do not begin to share with our public the many contributions our Knights have made to this community over the many years since the first chapter was established. [Council #1490 in the year 1910]

If you are interested in participating I ask you to please email me indicating your interest.

The Galt would be interested in any documents we might share that demonstrate our council's past history. These documents could include: the initial Charter date, name and inaugural membership, past Grand Knights names and dates, minutes of past meetings, records of significant activities and celebrations, charitable donations of time and resources, to name a few. Many of these documents are present in our club house and available for sharing.

Artifacts that might be shared include: dress wear used in ceremonial occasions, objects and adornments used in ceremonial events, material objects that represent significant contributions and/or participation in significant events and activities, to name a few. Kevin MacLean from the Galt would need to meet with the council to view the potential donation to determine its appropriateness and then submit it to the Galt Artifact Vetting Committee to determine its acceptability.

The most important part of these records would be a summary of the historical activities of our council. If you have any pictures or documents that demonstrate the past activities of our Council, these would be most welcome. Examples include: sporting events, installation of Officers, member knights participating in community events including church events, Camp Columbus, sponsorship of community teams or events, Western Tail Gate event, Oktoberfest event, etc.

I hope this begins to describe the importance of this project in preserving our past legacy and contributions. I sincerely hope that you will support the project and might donate any items in your possession that will add to the project bank of archives and artifacts in preserving the Knights of Columbus Councils of Lethbridge rich history.
