Words From The Pulpit



Wow, summer is almost over. We are two-thirds through Ordinary Time. How is your growing in faith coming?

Here are some major celebrations which will occur over the next two months.

- September 2nd Labour Day
- September 14th Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross
- September 21st Feast of Saint Matthew, apostle and evangelist
- September 30th National Day of Truth and Reconciliation
- October 7th Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary
- October 14th Thanksgiving Day
- October 18th Feast of Saint Luke, evangelist
- October 28th Feast of Saint Simon and Saint Jude, apostles
- November 1st Solemnity of All Saints
- November 2nd Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls)

As I am writing this article, I am reflecting on the month of August where we heard the Discourse on the Bread of Life from the Gospel according to St John. Jesus repeatedly said, "I am the Bread of Life." This is one of seven times in the Gospel that Jesus uses the statement "I am."

In isolation, the Bread of Life Discourse is more important but in the larger view, "I am," the same statement God uses with Moses, is Jesus linking the words spoken to Moses to the words Jesus is now telling His disciples. He is God and God is He. We identify Him as God the Son, but also remember

that when we talk of the Trinity, we talk in singularity, One God.

We should never forget that where the Son is, the Father and the Spirit are also. So, the next time you see the Eucharist, as it is elevated during Mass, or at Adoration, or pass the Tabernacle, say the words uttered by St Thomas upon being reunited to Jesus after the Resurrection, "My Lord, and my God!" Recognize that it is Jesus' body but also acknowledge the presence of God. This is why we Genuflect to the Tabernacle and kneel during the Eucharistic Prayer. This was taught as a silent prayer, for God could hear what is in your heart, but somehow it got lost, so it is now a quiet prayer said so that those around us can hear us vocalize our faith

May the Peace of Christ rest with you and your family and may you have a safe and enjoyable fall.

Pancake Breakfasts




After the summer break we are gearing up to serve breakfasts again this fall!

Proceeds from this breakfast will be donated to **Camp Columbus** in honour of our late **Brother Bob Rice**.


For our **October 13**th breakfast we will be donating the proceeds in support of **Sister Meagan** who will be taking her final vows on **November 30th.**






A couple months ago Brother Gerry Van Nistelrooy joined us at our Friday Night Social to celebrate his 95th birthday. (June 1)

Alex Misak 2017 Major Degree Honouree



Alex was born November 1935 in Coaldale, AB, the fourth child of five to Steve and Irma Misak.

He moved to Lethbridge in 1950 and attended St. Joseph's High School. In 1955, he joined the automotive industry and worked as a sales representative for 32 years, retiring in 1991.

He met the love of his life in 1959 while she was teaching at Gilbert Paterson School and they were married during the summer of 1960. Alex and Ruby are proud parents of four children;

Cheryl graduated with Distinction from the U of L, received her Masters at Columbia University in New York and her PhD in Oxford, England on a Rhodes Scholarship.

Brad also graduated from the U of L and is a probation officer working out of the Langley office.

Kevin earned his Masters in Education and has taught in Prague, Mexico and Turkey before settling down in Toronto, where he currently teaches at T.F.S., the only French private school in Toronto.

Christine graduated with an Arts Degree, taught in South Korea, Taiwan and Yellowknife and is currently teaching in Edmonton.

Alex and Ruby have five wonderful grandchildren, four of whom are attending graduate school in New York, Toronto and Vancouver.

Alex joined the Knights in Columbus Council #1490 in 1959, not taking on an executive position due to his work that took him out of town on meeting nights. Alex and Ruby, along with their family, enjoyed many family activities that the Knights of Columbus offered including family picnics, camp outs, baseball and golf tournaments, children's Christmas parties and others.

In 1985-86, he became Grand Knight of Council


#1490, receiving the Star Council Award with the generous help of FS. Fred Erler. Brother Fred was extremely efficient with his experience in the RCMP Fraud Squad.

State Deputy Charles Pratt asked Alex to organize and start a new chapter in the south so in 1987, the Southern Alberta Chapter was formed. The first Chapter President was Brother Con Schoening, member of Council #5726, followed by Alex. That year, Alex received the Council Knight of the Year Award from Council #1490. Alex was District Deputy (District #31) from 1990 to 1991, receiving the Star District Award and the New Council Award for instituting St. Patrick's Council #10547 on February 11, 1991.

After transferring to Council #5726, Alex thought he could slow down and spend more time on the golf course, his favourite pass time (not so). He became Grand Knight (1999-2000) and received his second Council of the Year Award. Alex became Chapter President again in 2009 and helped organize one of the best State Golf Tournaments, held at Paradise Canyon Golf and Country Club.

Presently he serves as Advocate of #5726 and is Treasurer with Camp Columbus. In the spring and fall, he serves as Caretaker Manager with the Parks Canada Ecosystem Investigator Camps.

Alex is an Honorary Life Member of both the third and fourth degree.
