We will hope to see many Brother Knights at our Councils Annual Christmas Party coming up on Dec 1, 2017. Please see the note in the newsletter for more information.

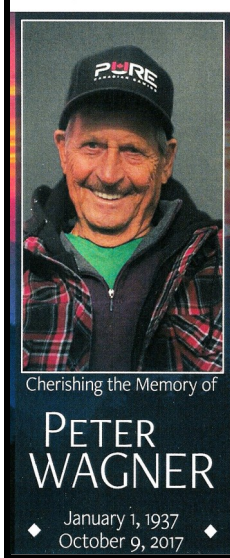

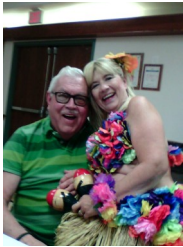


This is how close the fire came to the camp.

 Brothers, another calendar year is winding down and so it is time to reminisce about what has happened over the year 2017.

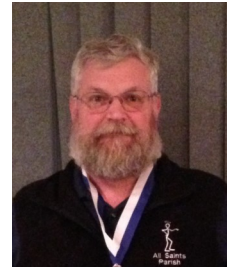
