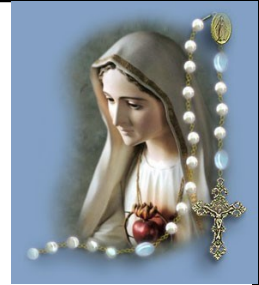


ROSARY COAST TO COAST

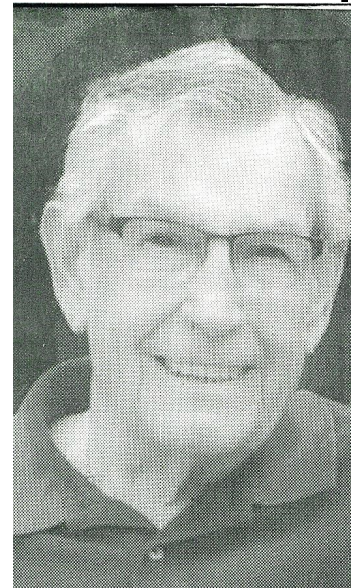

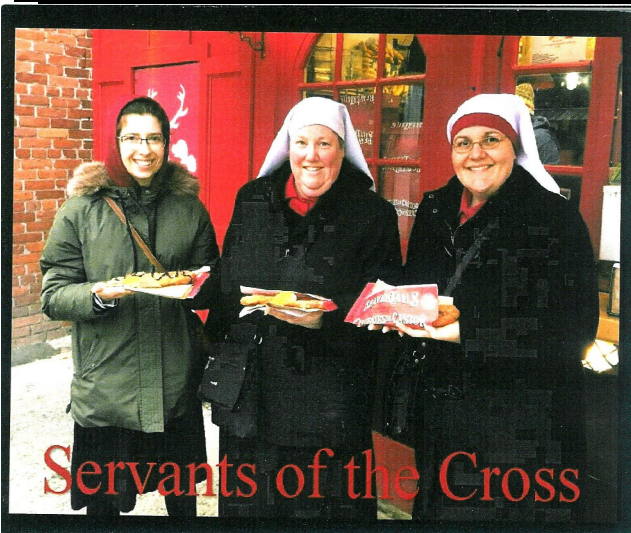

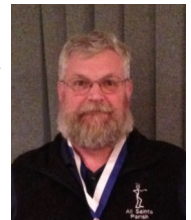
